- Personal Investment Enterprise (PIE) Program—matched savings and financial literacy program driving over \$1.25 million into our local economies. 19 PIE graduates in Lafayette 10 new homeowners, 4 new businesses and 5 entering higher education.
- We are the local sponsor of the EPIC book drive to benefit local children with limited access to books, especially during summer break. Thousands of books were provided to children in Boulder and Broomfield counties.
- FHUW's Volunteer Connection brings volunteer teams together with local non-profits that need help at projects in Lafayette.
- United Way's Volunteer Connection partnered with DOVIA Colorado to launch a local chapter ensuring an even stronger volunteer experience.
- 2-1-1 offers a free, simple way to call for information and referral addressing all kinds of challenges facing residents of Boulder and Broomfield counties.
- FHUW and 2-1-1 are partners with SCL's Good Samaritan Hospital to increase awareness of the 2-1-1 resource ensuring people in need have a live resource for a variety of needs.
- Day of Caring brings together 1,100 volunteers from 35-40 area businesses to work on over 60 volunteer projects for one morning in September at 40 to 50 sites in the area – including Lafayette.
- FHUW partners with No Student Hungry Partnership serving those suffering from food insecurity.
- FHUW partners with The Boulder County Assuring Better Child Health and Development (ABCD) Partnership streamlining access to developmental services for children in Boulder County.
- FHUW partners with the DV/CPS Collaboration & Consultation Team dedicated to keeping children in Boulder County safe while providing a supportive, nurturing environment while offering support to non-abusing parents who are also victims of domestic violence.
